JURISDICTION

Held under the National Sporting Code of the A.C.U. The Standing Regulations for Motocross, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting which have the same force as these regulations.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to Twinshock Solo Riders and Evo Riders, who are holders of an ACU National Competition Licence for Moto-cross. All entries must be made on the Official form and forwarded to the Secretary of the Meeting with the entry fee of **£60.00**

Entries will close on the 14th August 2016

CLASSES

Solo - KEN HALL SUPER EVO
KEN HALL OPEN TWIN SHOCK
KEN HALL TEAM CHALLENGE Each Team to consist of

One Rider on 125cc EVO, One Rider on 250cc Evo and One Rider on 500cc Evo

PLEASE PUT YOUR TEAM NAME ON THE ENTRY FORM

Amalgamation of classes categories may be required. All Classes are subject to a minimum Entry of 25

INSURANCE

The Insurance for this event will be Basic Insurance (Limit of Liability £10M) and Medical Malpractice Insurance (Limit of Liability £5M) is included There is NO Personal Accident Insurance for Competitors

COURSE

Approximately 1.75 miles of grassland with natural ascents and descents.
Track will be modified to suit Twin Shock Machines

AWARDS

Trophies to 3rd place.

POINTS

Overall positions in all events to be decided on points. If a tie results, then the highest place in the last race wins

1st 20, 2nd 17, 3rd 15, 4th 13, 5th 11, 6th 10, 7th 9, 8th 8, 9th 7, 10th 6, 11th 5, 12th 4, 13th 3, 14th 2, 15th 1.

NUMBERS

All riders to be notified of their riding numbers by post SEVEN days prior to the meeting.

PRACTICE

Official practice will be controlled between 9.30 a.m. and 10-45 a.m. First Race 11.00a.m.

START PROCEDURE

Clutch start controlled by drop down gate.

PROTESTS

As per the National Sporting Code.

SCRUTINEERING

Machines and clothing to be scrutineered between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. Saturday 27th, 8am to 9-15 am Sunday 28th All riders must sign on prior to the commencement of practice.

POWER WASHERS

NO POWER WASHERS TO BE USED IN THE PADDICK

BIKE WASH AREA WILL BE PROVIDED and may be used but only in accordance with the F.I.M. Environmental Code.

ADMISSION PASSES

Solo's 2 passes. All others must pay. Any Competitor trying to get free admission for Family, Friends or Helpers without a Pass will be excluded.

LICENCES

An A.C.U. National Licence, or if an A.C.U. One Day Licence is required, a fee of **£15** should accompany the Entry Fee's.

THE RIDING OF PADDOCK BIKES PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES

N.B.

1. No entry to the paddock between 10.00pm Saturday and 0700 Hrs Sunday
2. Only mechanics wearing valid passes will be allowed into the mechanic/ signal area.
3. All dogs must be kept on leads.
4. A work area will be provided. If a Rider returns to the Paddock during the Race he will be excluded
5. Bike Washing only in the Bike Wash Area
6. Competitors are responsible for the behaviour of their teams and helpers at all time.
